Brewers Community Foundation Awards Grant to Dominican Center to Support Amani Youth in Action Program and Activities for Youth and Their Families at Moody Park

Milwaukee, WI – February 15, 2018. Brewers Community Foundation awarded \$5,000 to the Dominican Center and the grant will support Dominican Center’s Amani Youth in Action program and activities for youth and their families at Moody Park.

The Dominican Center and Amani residents recognize the importance of Amani youth engagement that promotes education, leadership development, and community engagement for those between the ages of 8 and 18. The grant will specifically pay for t-shirts, caps, gloves, lawn maintenance supplies, snacks, and field trips. These supplies support programming in Moody Park for youth, their families, and for Amani Youth in Action participants. Partaking in field trips is especially important as many Amani youth have never ventured outside of their neighborhood.
