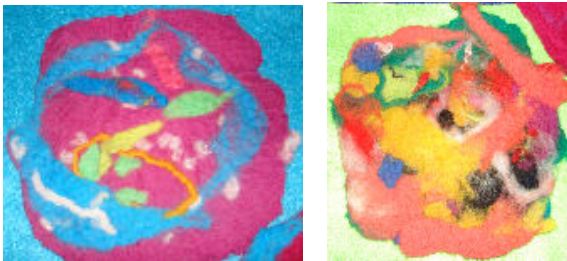

FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends,

Although 2008-2009 has not been the best year for many, fortunately we have found that it has been a rich one for the Center, as the following will attest:

- Enrolled 50 students, 23 of whom persevered and 3 of whom won First Prize in MATC's "Readers as Writers" contest.
- Provided community service opportunities for 9 people, which allowed them to perform volunteer service to work off their court fines.
- Assisted 14 neighborhood homeowners to beautify and bring their homes up to code.
- Were invited to expand our contract with the City of Milwaukee Health Department so that we grew from having one healthy housing staff member to three. Both lead abatement and asthma abatement practices will inform our housing program contributing to our "green" rehab efforts.
- Initiated a "Dreams Come True" project, where we will invest Dominican Center dollars to help fund labor and supplies for critical rehab needs of DC senior housing.
- Collaborated with the YMCA to put on a Healthy Housing Fair which over 400 attended.
- Held a successful annual fundraiser where we cleared just under \$20,000.
- Developed a 5-year strategic plan, complete with actions and timelines.
- Were awarded by the Housing Trust Fund Committee a grant of \$147,000 to assist neighborhood homeowners make their homes code compliant. The DC has to match those funds.
- Collaborated with District 5 police and churches in the area to promote resident involvement through meetings and community events.
- Completed a 2-year program with Professional Dimensions which benefited DC programs through 8 additional tutors, 13 scribes to assist with life stories, volunteer labor for our housing program and a collaborative art project which resulted in 2 banners now gracing the DC gathering room.
- Engaged an advisory group of professionals, directors of resources, community residents and others. This is a volunteer group that meets monthly to seek out new ways to assist in promoting the Center's mission through collaboration and partnership.
- Sponsored the Catholic Heart Work Camp for the sixth year. This year we had 22 teams working in 21 homes.

- Helped develop a senior outreach program in conjunction with the City of Milwaukee Department of Aging. The program will be ongoing under the leadership of neighborhood residents.

All of the above are quantifiable; however, the most significant achievements are not quantifiable and can only be seen by experiencing the enormous outpouring of support, respect and encouragement by all who are part of the Center. This year truly has been a rich one.
